The objectives include:

- Nurture and solidify cross-sector and intergovernmental partnerships, led by the Ho-Chunk Nation, Sauk County, and the county's five Chambers of Commerce.
- Engage a broad cross-section of stakeholders, e.g., millennials, activists, entrepreneurs, educators, high schoolers, leaders from villages and townships, for their input and ideas for Sauk County's future vision.
- Identify and prioritize the most critical trends facing the county, so that plans laid in the near-term are responsive and sustainable.

The SCDC Fall Leadership Forum series continues to share workforce/housing, retention/expansion and collaboration strategies for business and municipalities in Sauk County and Wisconsin's greater South-Central region.
